Boulevard II differentiates itself from Boulevard panels in that it provides lay-in capability of cables at the top of the panel **1** and provides a vertical channel **2** to bring power and data/communications down to the raceway. Boulevard II can be integrated with Boulevard panels, effectively protecting your investment. The innovative beltline raceway merges wire management from floor to ceiling and allows two desk height accessibility options: exposed face-mount receptacles for plug and play or **3** enclosed receptacles that permit a seamless panel surface. The

new face-mount power feed **4** provides power directly to the raceway without having to first come through a post. A two part extruded aluminum pole **5** allows for lay-in installation of data and communication cables. The pole assembly can be installed off-module anywhere along the top of the panel. Stack on over panels allow more flexibility and create a tiled effect. Over panels are fitted with two uprights at either end that slide into the base panel's vertical extrusions.



Increased cable capacity simplifies the routing of cables between panels and on top of the door-frame. The Boulevard II panel almost doubles cable capacity.



The vertical channel brings power and data/communication cables to the raceway as shown here with the fabric and raceway cover removed from the panel.



Stack on over panels enhances Boulevard's appearance and provides strength and stability to a panel run or floor to ceiling application. Simply slide the over panel's uprights into the base panel. Panels can be stacked one on top of the other.



# Boulevard II

The flexibility to adapt to different work styles, design schemes, and budgets is key to Boulevard's appeal. The product line includes fabric or glazed panels, doors, and work surface components that can be used separately or in conjunction with freestanding mobile furniture such as Viceversa, and wood or laminate casegoods. Workstations would not be complete without filing and storage. Boulevard offers several styles of filing and storage that add to the functionality of your personal space or provide ample storage and filing capacity for the open office. Sleek aluminum trim enhances the appearance of the panel. Can be used on both Boulevard and Boulevard II panels. Existing Boulevard Installations can be upgraded simply by adding new top caps, trims, and end caps.



## Viceversa Overhead Hutch

This overhead hutch has sliding frosted tempered glass doors that can be mounted to a Boulevard panel. Viceversa hutches are available in 36", 42", and 48" widths.



## Radius Personal Storage Tower

This radius front tower is available in box and/or file drawer combinations. The closet has a pull out coat rod, magnetic mirror and a shoe/boot tray. The top of the closet has air holes to allow air to flow through. Towers with box drawers have one organizer tray and two CD/DVD racks. All openings lock by a single conveniently located lock. Radius towers are 65" high.



## Linear Personal Storage Tower

This tower has a flat front with soft touch pulls on doors and drawers. The top of the closet has air holes to allow air to flow through. A shoe/boot tray and magnetic mirror is included in the closet. Towers with box drawers have one pencil tray. Doors and drawers lock individually. Linear towers are available in 54" and 65" heights.
